

Listening to Radio Warneford on the Roberts Stream 104 Radio

Some of the wards at Warwick Hospital have been equipped with a Roberts Stream 104 radio that allows you to listen to Radio Warneford without having to use a mobile phone or other internet device. The current list of wards where a radio has been installed is shown below.

When it is switched on, the radio will always play the station that it was last tuned in to. This may not always be Radio Warneford so just follow the instructions below if you need to re-tune the set to hear our programmes. We have also included details of how to tune the radio to listen to other stations if you want to.

For best results, we recommend that the radio is always left plugged into a power socket and that you use the **Power Off / Standby** button to switch the radio on and off. You do not need to extend the aerial when listening to Radio Warneford but you will do if you use our tuning guide to listen to another station via DAB radio.

To Listen To Radio Warneford

- Press the **Power On / Standby** button.
- Press the **Mode** button several times until the display shows “Internet Radio”.
- Press the **Preset** button.
- Turn the **Tuning / Select** knob to select “Radio Warneford”.

To Listen To Another Radio Station

We hope you find our programmes interesting and will stay listening to Radio Warneford. However if you need a change, the radio has been set up with a range of other stations.

- Press the **Mode** button several times until the display shows “DAB Radio”.
- Press the **Preset** button.
- Turn the **Tuning / Select** knob to select the station you want to listen to.
